#### For a Sick Child

O LORD Jesus Christ, who didst with joy receive and bless the children brought to thee, give thy blessing to this thy child: In thine own time deliver *him* from *his* bodily pain, that *he* may live to serve thee all *his* days. Who livest and reignest, world without end. Amen.

#### For Healing

O GOD, who by the might of thy command canst drive away from men's bodies all sickness and infirmity: be present in thy goodness with this thy servant, that his weakness being banished, and his health restored, he may live to glorify thy Holy Name. Through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

O ALMIGHTY God, who art the giver of all health, and the aid of them that turn to thee for succour: we entreat thy strength and goodness in behalf of this thy servant, that *he* may be healed of *his* infirmities, to thine honor and glory; through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

O CHRIST our Lord, who art the Physician of Salvation, grant unto the sick the aid of heavenly healing. Look upon all faithful people who are sick, and take their souls into thy keeping, and vouchsafe to deliver them from all infirmity; Who livest and reignest, world without end. Amen.

#### **Prayer for the Suffering**

O GOD, the Father of all, look down in pity on those who suffer, and heal the anguish of the world; release from the prison-house all held in the bondage of fear, and set free such as are bound by the fetters of disease, whether of soul or body. O GOD, whose never-failing Providence ordereth all things both in heaven and earth; hear the humble prayers of thy servant, and direct the hand of the surgeon and prosper his skill to a merciful and blessed issue. Through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

### Where There Appears Small Hope of Recovery

O FATHER of mercies, and God of all comfort, our only help in time of need; We fly unto thee for succour in behalf of this thy servant lying in great weakness of body. Look graciously upon him, O Lord; and the more the outward man decayeth, strengthen him so much the more continually with thy grace and Holy Spirit in the inner man. Give him unfeigned repentance for all the errors of his life past, and steadfast faith in thy Son Jesus; that his sins may be done away by thy mercy, and his pardon sealed in heaven; through the same thy Son, our Lord and Saviour. Amen.

#### For a Convalescent

O LORD, whose compassions fail not, and whose mercies are new every morning: we give thee hearty thanks that it hath pleased thee to give to this our *brother* both relief from pain and hope of renewed health; continue, we beseech thee, in *him* the good work that thou hast begun; that, daily increasing in bodily strength, and humbly rejoicing in thy goodness, *he* may so order *his* life and conversation as always to think and do such things as shall please thee. Through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

#### Thanksgiving for Recovery

O LORD God, giver of live and health; I most heartily thank thee, that in thy mercy, thou hast delivered me from sickness and affliction, and with a grateful heart I desire to offer unto thy fatherly goodness myself, my soul and body, to be a living sacrifice unto thee, always praising and magnifying thy loving-kindness in the midst of thy Church. Through Christ our Lord. Amen.

O LORD Jesus Christ, who came not to be ministered unto but to minister, I praise thee for the blessings of medical science whereby my bodily health has been restored; give me grace to recognize that thy ministry is continued by priests, pastors, and physicians, and that thou art still the Good Physician of the souls and bodies of men. Who livest and reignest, world without end. Amen.



## COMMUNION OF THE SICK

■ When the Priest is to administer Holy Communion outside of the Church, he carries the Blessed Sacrament in a pyx suspended over his breast. It is not customary to reserve the Precious Blood and it would be exceedingly dangerous to carry the Blessed Sacrament about in this species. Thus Communion outside of the Church has been administered in one kind only since the earliest days. The Glorified Christ cannot be divided and is present in the tiniest particle of either species. In receiving the Sacred Host only, the Communicant receives all of our Lord.
